VASH is The Visitor Aloha Society of Hawai'i Island. "Caring for Visitors Touched by Adversities." We are a Big Island non-profit organization that was established in 2002. VASH is dedicated to promoting and sharing the Aloha Spirit with every traveler that has experienced hardship while visiting the Big Island. We want every visitor to feel welcomed, supported, and safe during their time on the island.

Since opening our doors (and hearts), we have assisted more than 20,000 visitors, including support to more than 400 death cases. The adversities they faced were varied, including: kidnaping, physical assault, sexual assault, attempted suicide, suicide, attempted murder, murder, near drowning, drowning and death from other causes, medical emergencies, lodging scams, vehicle theft, rental car and lodging break-ins, being stranded, and lost and stolen items.

VASH's aid includes providing emotional support, emergency transportation and lodging, clothing, food, medical equipment loans, interpreters, and more. By stepping in to provide this assistance, VASH supports our already thinly-stretched police and health workers by relieving them of the need to help travelers beyond their professional responsibilities.

VASH has also long supported the tourism industry by educating travelers on physical and health safety issues that are unique to our island, lessening the strain on the EMS system. Throughout all of our support to our visitors-in-need, we hope the end result is that they will go home feeling the Aloha Spirt within them, even though they faced adversity while here.

RULES OF THE DAY

- 1. Tee Selection: Each team selects one player to tee off first. The team then selects the best tee shot among the four players and marks the spot.
- 2. Ball Placement: After the best tee shot is selected, all team members place their balls within one club length of the chosen spot. Each player hits their next shot from this new location.
- 3. Shot Selection: Once all players have hit their shots, the team selects the best shot again. This process continues for each shot, including approach shots, chip shots, and putts.
- 4. Repeating the Process: The team repeats the process of selecting the best shot and all players hitting from that spot until the ball is holed.
- 5. Scoring: After completing all the holes, the team's score is the total number of strokes taken. The team with the lowest score wins the competition.
